

Between 2015 and 2021, ideas took shape. They became full-blown pieces of music whose writing we have always been keen on taking good care of. An elaborate demo served as the template for our new album "Withered Flowers And Cinnamon", which Mr. Kunio Suma (Bi Kyo Ran) honored us by playing on.





Prior to that in 2011, our second album, "Teardrops In Morning Dew" had been released on Galileo Records -- an album with a darker temper and a greater variety of atmospheres, featuring an eponymous epic translating into music the successive psychological phases which affect a human being confronted with mourning.



Our debut album, "Remembrance" (Musea Records), was released in 2005. It features reworked, previously recorded songs. This first album also delivers the last part of the "Dreamscape" trilogy.





A very different line-up with the arrival of Arnaud Perret on bass and Manu Mercier on guitar. More rock music, jazz-rock. Lots of riffs and complex arrangements.

ENNEADE - Remembrance, Tortured progressive rock

With this first album, Lyons-based combo enneade strike hard. Indeed, Remembrance is a fine demonstration of both melodic and tortured progressive-rock know-how, in a not-so-dark (and with keyboards) recent King Crimson style. The combo's pieces are thus marked by very clear though very present drums, and an often crystal-clear guitar which however knows how to be violent when the context requires it. The long epic that opens this album, "King of Silver", is a beautiful demonstration of enneade 's ability to elegantly navigate elegantly troubled waters, between progressive and metal. This song thus contains passages of powerful progressive metal, entangled with much more stripped down moments. The atmospheres are heavily wrought with many long ramp-ups ("Open the Gates"). The accoustic guitar parts are very beautiful and gentle ("The Dreamscape"), halfway between Steve Hackett (Genesis) and Mikael **Akerfeld (Opeth)**. But the most interesting thing about it is that this album reveals an already well-constructed and relatively original personality, which is quite rare. Some improvements can still be made, in terms of vocals (which lacks a little depth and daring) or production (while being more than decent, we would have like it to knit the instruments together a little more), but Remembrance is as such a highly recommendable record.

ENNEADE-REMEMBRANCE - (Musea - 2005 - France)

enneade was the name of a compilation published by Musea, dedicated to the Zeuhl current. The band of the same name mustn't be aware of it as no trace of this type of music is to be found in their first album, the rerecording of a demo sent to the label in 2005.

Already present in our columns through a title in the compilation of Lyons-based groups, From the Lyon's vaults published in 2001, enneade pours into a "dreamtheaterisation" of a progressive yet provided with progressive snipets having nothing to do with the rest of their metal-injected material.

The excellence of the ceaseless chords, bridges and breaks justifies the trust given by Musea must have had a crush on the progressive aspect of certain aspects of their music, inspired by Rush with the multiple misleading tracks set out in the fantastic King of silver with its 17 min 49, seasoned with little digressions worthy of the Crimson King himself, sublime moments of escape and lulls staged with a taste for the progressive unsusual for a comba whose average age should exempt them from having known the great era. This will make the listener and even more so the critic more than admiring of the work of enneade.

In their description of the band, Musea did not hesitate to mention similarities with Opeth or Anathema, which sets the level of musical intransigence demanded by the Lyons six-piece. Resemblances invoked thanks to the rough frontal collusions with a musical style in full mutation, particularly in these two groups, sailing on sight towards the shores of a less explosive progressive but oh so much richer than the chords bordering on death metal evoked by the beginnings of the groups in question.

Yes, despite a pseudonym smacking of the bucolic scents of 70's rock, enneade remains a combo with metallic power tamed by a truckload of brand new progressive groove, inherited from an old garage in disuse and unearthed at the bottom of a greasy cardboard.

The multiplication of influences fades in the face of a readiness to embrace, digest or even swallow-up entire schools of progressive from which enneade derives a quintessence unlike any other. The beautiful guitar sounds of The dreamscape even go so far as to evoke the most beautiful snipets of Steve Hackett, Polaroids from a bygone era that the members of enneade have learned to enjoy from long hours of listening - or Bob's my uncle! When a new group - and a French one too! (let's not be modest!) -- reaches this degree of excellence in emotions, we no longer say "essential" or "to buy urgently", we declaim, emphatic and hypnotized, another redundancy of critical art, THE REVELATION OF THE YEAR!! Yes, I know, I'm writing this in January... We'll see ... but what a slap in the face ...


